

Cabin Reservations

Reservations can be made on the CampIt KS mobile app, online at reserveamerica.com, by calling (316) 542-3664 or in person at the state park office.

If making a weekend reservation, the cabin must be reserved for both nights; holiday weekends require a three night stay.

A \$13.75 non-refundable reservation fee is added to all cabin reservations.

A \$75 damage deposit will be required at check-in. Damage deposits can be made by credit card or check. Checks should be made out to: FRIENDS OF CHENEY LAKE INC.

Reservations are not in effect until payment-in-full is received.

Permits Required

A daily vehicle permit, \$5, is required to visit any Kansas state park. Seniors over the age of 65 may purchase a daily vehicle permit for \$3.25.

Modern Cabins

The Heron cabin is a one-bedroom cabin equipped with a full-sized bed and single futon couch in the bedroom, a double futon bed and single Murphy bed in the living room/kitchen and a furnished kitchen. The Osprey, Crappie, Walleye and Catfish cabins are two-bedroom single room cabins equipped with a full-sized bed and futon couch in one bedroom, two sets of bunk beds in another bedroom, a double

futon bed in the living room/kitchen, as well as a furnished kitchen, heating and air conditioning.

Sleeper Cabins

Cabins #2 – #7 are one-room cabins that have a full-sized bed and a set of bunk beds. Cabin #8 offers a full-sized bed, a single bunk bed and one roll-away single bed. It also has a deck instead of a screened porch.

Each sleeper cabin includes a dorm-room sized refrigerator, microwave, toaster, coffee pot, heating and air conditioning, table and chairs and an outside grill.

Pricing

Cabin prices vary seasonally by park and amenities offered. Peak season prices are in effect April 1 to September 30. During peak season, online reservations can be made a minimum of two days in advance. Off-season prices are in effect October 1 to March 31. During this time, online reservations can be made a minimum of five days in advance. To make a reservation after the online cutoff time, call (316) 542-3664.
